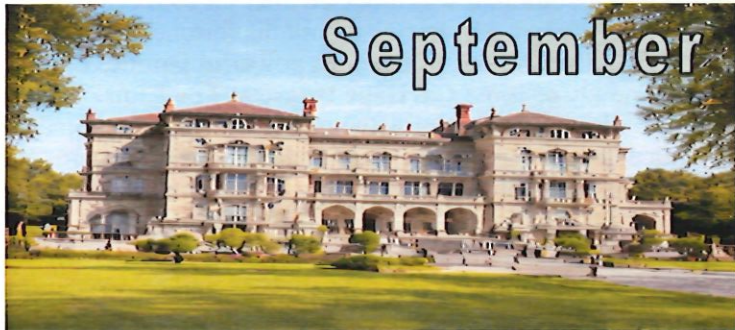
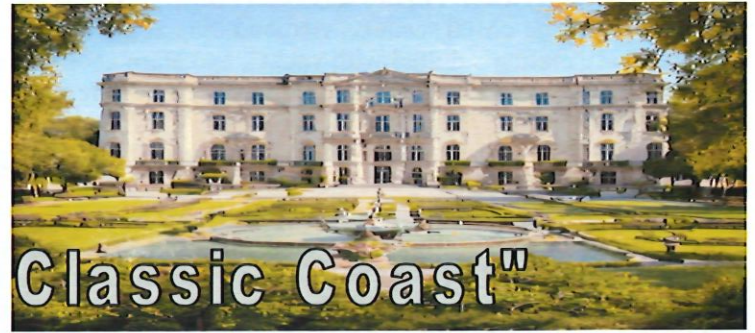
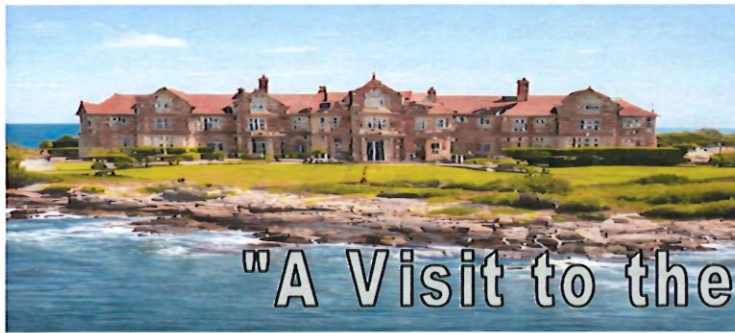


NEWPORT, RHODE ISLAND

Sample Itinerary:

Day 1: Travel to eastern Pennsylvania for our first night.

Day 2: Continue to **Newport, Rhode Island**. In 2018 Conde Nast Traveler recognized Newport as “One of the Most Beautiful Towns in America”. Forbes has referred to Newport as “Among the 35 Most Welcoming Places on Earth”. Soak in miles of spectacular costal scenery, visit and dine at incredible Gilded Age Mansions, saunter along the wharves of the bustling waterfront, see marina’s dotted with yachts, and learn about the powerful industrialist families that “summered” in Newport. Upon arrival visit **Rough Point Mansion** the Newport home of heiress, collector, and philanthropist Doris Duke. Experience Doris Duke’s life and legacy, and a historic landscape with panoramic views of the Atlantic ocean. Check in for **(3) nights** at the **Wyndham Hotel Newport/Middletown**. www.wyndhamnewportri.com **Dinner included.**

Day 3: Newport is a special place, and while here, we want you to experience highlights attached to the **Gilded Age**. This means, not only visiting these iconic mansions, but dining as well. Start our day with a guided **Cliff Walk Tour**. This easy walking tour features the **Atlantic Ocean** on one side and **The Mansions** on the other. The walk passes **(7) mansions** with stories dating back to 1639. Next, a **guided tour of Newport’s Ocean Drive** with (10) miles of commanding coastline. Tour along historic **Bellevue Avenue** to view the incredible **Gilded Age Mansions**, and see **Hammersmith Farm** where Jackie Kennedy grew up. Mid day we’re at **The Elms Mansion**, a stunning symbol of Gilded Age ambition. It was modeled after an 18th century French Chateau, and was the summer home of Mr. and Mrs. Edward Julius Berwind. Mr. Berwind built his fortune on the vast coal industry that powered America’s rise to global prominence. The Berwind’s were one of the most powerful families of the Gilded Age. **Tour the mansion** then join us for a **delightful lunch** at the newly restored **Carriage House** at **The Elms**. The lovely Carriage House is on the mansion grounds overlooking the historic Elms gardens. Enjoy the rest of the afternoon on the **Newport Harbor**. Meander cobblestone streets and bustling harbor with eclectic shops, charming boutiques, historic charm and waterfront pubs and restaurants. **Conde Nast Traveler names Newport the Best Walking City in the U.S.**

Day 4: Visit **Breakers Mansion**, the grandest of Newport’s “summer cottages”, and a symbol of the Vanderbilt family’s social and financial pre-eminence in the Gilded Age. It is the flagship of the Newport Mansions and an icon of the **City-by-the-Sea**. After lunch take a **Newport Harbor Boat Cruise**. Later join us for an **included dinner** at **The Mooring**, an upscale restaurant overlooking the Newport Harbor.

Day 5: A final highlight starts our morning. Visit and tour **Marble House**, another **National Historic Landmark**. William Vanderbilt built Marble House as a 39th birthday present to his wife Alva. It was a social and architectural landmark that set the pace for Newport’s subsequent transformation from a quiet summer colony of wooden houses to the legendary resort of opulent Gilded Age mansions. Plus enjoy a unique **luncheon experience** at the iconic **Chinese Tea House, on the grounds of Marble House** above the historic **Cliff Walk**. After lunch our local guide takes us on an engaging presentation about the **history of U.S. Suffrage**, which concludes our memorable Newport holiday. Mid afternoon start our journey home staying in Pennsylvania.
