

Holland Ponds Park - 50385 Ryan Road, Shelby Twp. MI, 48316

Holland Ponds Park features 200 acres of native habitat. Known for beautiful walking trails, Holland Ponds welcomes bird watchers and hikers. The park displays Shelby Township's history on the abandoned Clinton-Kalamazoo Canal, which dates to 1838.

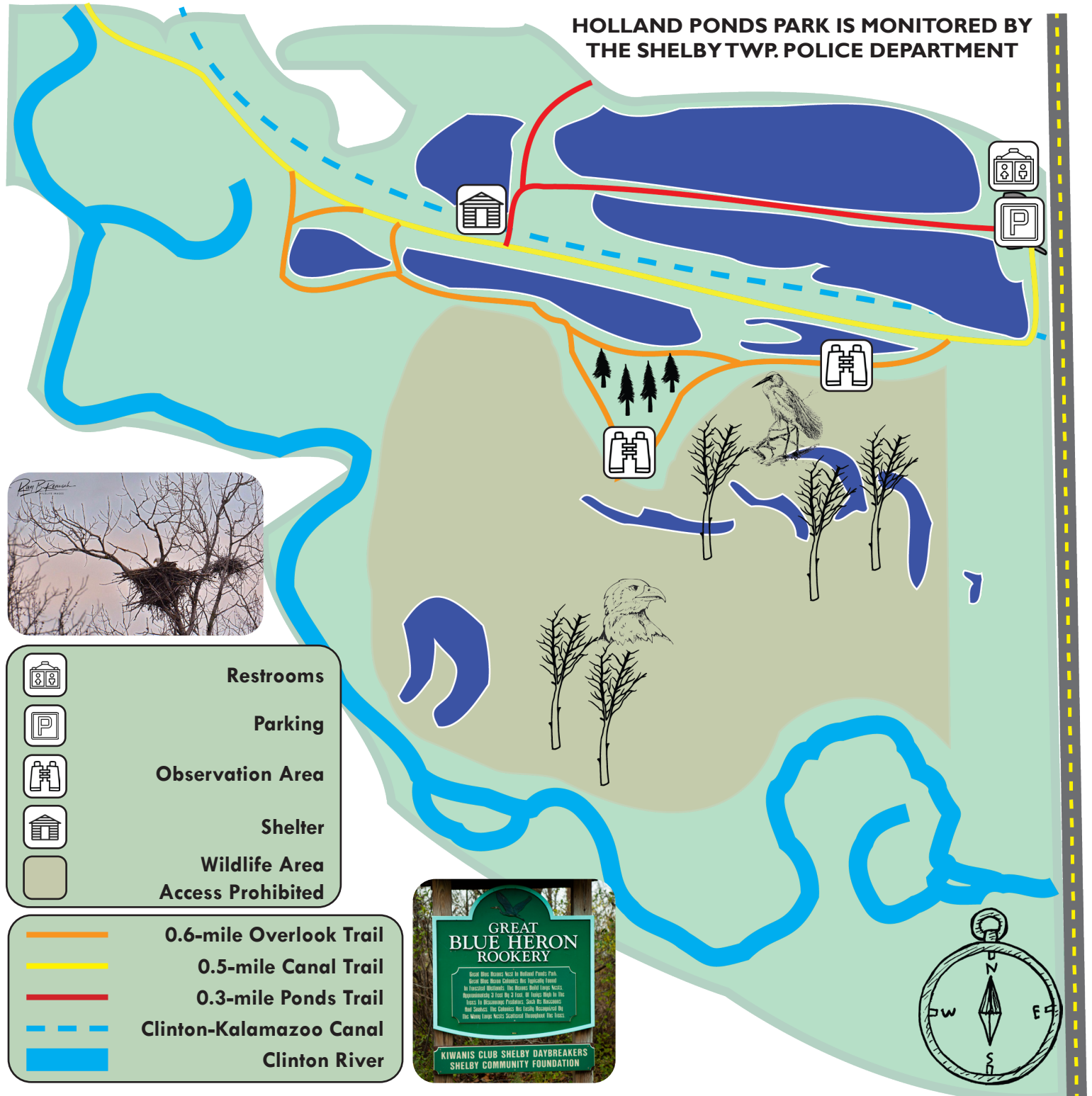
A small shelter is found in the back of the park and portable restrooms are at the entrance. Adjacent to the former G & H Landfill, the area was feared lost because of contamination. After decades of clean up, the park houses thriving wildlife, fish and plant communities including eagles, herons and egrets.
