Sample Itinerary

Day 1: Fly Non-stop Detroit to Denver. Dinner included.

Day 2: A memorable day involves a trip through **Rocky Mountain National Park**. Ancient upheavals, volcanic eruptions and glacial scouring cut and carved great diversity and incredible beauty into this multi-faceted gem. The altitude from 7,500 to 14,250 feet slices through mountain, sub-alpine and alpine zones. A drive up **Trail Ridge Road** takes you to the **Arctic Circle** ecologically, yet you're only (2) hours from Denver. Stop in beautiful **Estes Park** in the heart of the Rocky Mountains. Majestic views span in every direction along with stunning panoramic scenes you expect from a Colorado mountain town. Spend some leisure time in the quaint downtown.

Day 3: Board the **Amtrak's California Zephyr** for "**One of the Top 10 Train Rides in the World**". The epic daylight passage through the Colorado Rocky Mountains, through spectacular **Glenwood Canyon** is world-class. This route is only accessible by rail and offers breathtaking views of mountains, canyons, and the Colorado River. Our destination is **Grand Junction, CO** for overnight.

Day 4: Continue south to **Silverton, CO**, nestled between two rugged **San Juan Mountain** passes. Enjoy some time mid-day in this historic old mining town. This afternoon board the **Durango Silverton Narrow Gauge Railroad** for a scenic rail excursion to **Durango, CO**. The scenery is spectacular as we experience iconic **Horseshoe Curve, High Bridge, and Animas River Gorge** including all of the breathtaking views from the **High Line**. Arrive in **Durango** for (2) nights at the historic **Strater Hotel**. www.strater.com **Dinner and entertainment are included at the Bar D Old West Cowboy Music Show and Chuckwagon Dinner.**

Day 5: Take a day trip to **Mesa Verde National Park (UNESCO)**, home of the ancient Ancestral Puebloan civilization. Join a local guide on a drive through the park with several photo stops. Highlights include the famous **Spruce Tree House**, one of Mesa Verde's best preserved cliff dwelling and **Cliff Palace**, the largest in the park.

Day 6: Our tour continues with a scenic ride to **Colorado Springs**. The impressive landscape takes us through the **San Juan National Forest** and across **Wolf Creek Pass**, a section of the **Continental Divide**. Continue through the **Rio Grande National Forest** to **Great Sand Dunes National Park**. The tallest dunes in North America are the centerpiece in a diverse landscape of grasslands, wetlands, forests, alpine lakes, and tundra. Arrive in **Colorado Springs** for (3) nights.

Day 7: Enjoy a morning tour of the **Garden of the Gods** and witness dramatic views of 300 foot towering rock formations. Next, board the **Pike Peak Cog Railway**, the world's highest cog rail. Recognized as one of the most unique experiences in the country, this is certainly a tour highlight. Embark on a 9-mile rail journey to Pike Peak's 14,115 foot summit. On a clear day, you can see (5) states: Colorado, Arizona, New Mexico, Utah, and Kansas. After the journey enjoy some leisure time for shopping and an **included dinner** in quaint village of **Manitou Springs**.

Day 8: Our last day features two more incredible attractions. Visit the **Royal Gorge Bridge & Park**, home of **America's Highest Suspension Bridge**. Step by step, walk the 1,257 wooden planks suspended 956 feet over the Arkansas River across the world famous **Royal Gorge Bridge**. Visit the Plaza theatre for documentary about the history surrounding the park. All aboard the **Sky Gondola's** as you glide 2,200 feet across the spectacular Gorge, 1,200 feet above the Arkansas River. This afternoon board the **Royal Gorge Railroad** for an unmatched journey through Colorado's grandest canyon, and the most amazing section of railroad in the country. **Dinner included.**

Day 9: Fly from **Denver non-stop** home to **Detroit** and transfer back home.
