

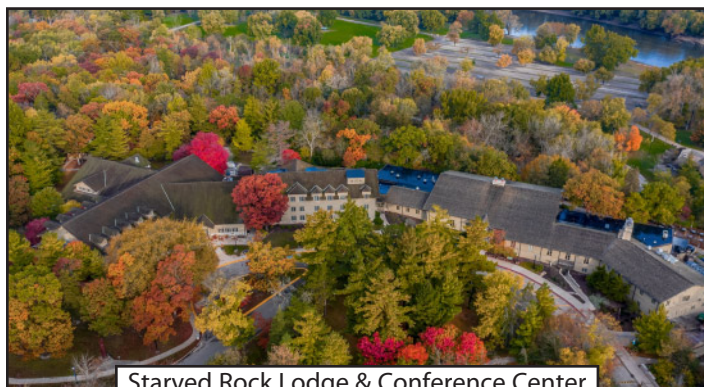

Day 1

Today, we are greeted by our professional Bianco tour guide and driver and begin our journey to Illinois. With plenty of stops enroute we will arrive to our first attraction this afternoon, the **Starved Rock Visitor Center**. Starved Rock State Park, nestled along the Illinois River in La Salle County, stands out as one of the most stunning spots in Illinois. Established as the state's second state park in 1911, it boasts 18 canyons with striking vertical walls of moss-laden St. Peter Sandstone, shaped by glacial meltwater over 14,000 years ago. With over 13 miles of trails, visitors can explore rain-fed waterfalls, sandstone overhangs, and breathtaking viewpoints. During our visit at the visitor center we will have the opportunity to watch a 15-minute movie on the history of the park and explore the gift shop. From there a short drive will get us to **Starved Rock Lodge & Conference Center**, our accommodations for the next two nights. Relax in the comfort of the historic lodge accommodations, with spacious hotel rooms set among the pines, canyons and waterfalls of the park. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, this authentic log-built lodge exudes a mix of rustic luxury, Midwestern hospitality and comfortable amenities. The inviting accommodations, delicious restaurants and unlimited outdoor adventure are waiting for you. Dinner is included tonight at the lodge.

Day 2

After an included breakfast you will have the morning free to explore the park. Take a 6 minute hike to the French Canyon Waterfall or a 20 minute hike to the Eagle Cliff Overlook - or just enjoy the indoor heated pool and hot tub. This afternoon we will enjoy a lunch buffet as we listen to the **Songs of Summer Tribute Show**. Matt and Cynthia Gruel of Nostalgia Entertainment bring you "Heatwave! Vintage Songs of Summer!"
